## Program Admission Requirements

**Professional Experience:** Candidates must have at least 2 years of postgraduate professional experience.

**Education:** Candidates must have an undergraduate degree from a regionally accredited college or university, and a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher is recommended.

### Application:

- **Transcripts** from all undergraduate and graduate institutions you attended, including schools where you did not earn a degree.
- **Resume or CV** detailing all previous work experience.
- **Personal statement** that clearly describes the uniqueness of your character and abilities; your experiences with issues of diversity; and your academic, community service, and career history.
- **Two letters of recommendation** that address your intellectual and personal capabilities.
- **GMAT or GRE scores** are required (school code 5297).
